Saffricon, the first official farming producer in South Africa, is offering trial packs for producers to explore farming with saffron. With support from Saffricon, the producer plants and cultivates saffron on their own land. The buyback of flower threads is guaranteed. Package options for farming and for the home gardener are available.

SAFFRON CHARACTERISTICS

- Winter crop: March to October.
- Temperature threshold of -15°C to 45°C.
- Moderate quantity of irrigation water required.
- Frost resistant.
- Low fertiliser cost.
- Low production cost.
- Labour intensive during flowering in April.
- Low maintenance throughout the rest of the year.
- Mediterranean climate.
- Sandy, loam soil.
- Saffron can be planted in a summer rainfall area, but well-draining soil is essential.

PRODUCTION BENEFITS

- Excellent crop to diversify the farming enterprise.
- A fair amount of land can generate a high return.
- Income potential from saffron.
- Planting material provided is already acclimatised to the Southern Hemisphere.

SAFFRON ORDER OPTIONS

1. TRIAL PACK

For farming and specifically for the trial run.

Includes:

- 7 kg Saffron corms of different sizes for 20 m², roughly 500 – 700 corms.
- Fertiliser and saffron specific fertilisation program
- Soil sample, analysed by NviroTek and Agri Technovation with saffron specific suggestions.
- Saffron Grower's Manual and online training with planting instructions and support.
- MYFARMWEB™ platform to monitor the data.

2. BUY-TO-OWN PACK

The Buy-to-Own, harvest delivery and purchase agreement:

- Saffricon sells saffron corms to the farmer for planting on their own.
- The farmer should deliver 100% of the saffron harvested from the corms to Saffricon at the prevailing market saffron price, subject to the authorised ISO grading quality of the specific harvest.
- The agreement is for 36 months (3 planting seasons) with the specific intention to include the first year of saffron planting and harvesting season.
- After the 36 months, there will be an option to renew the agreement for a further 36 month period.
